ON SCREEN SUPER:

Chemistry

Real Deal on Fakes

Didi: My name is Didi and I'm an ex-drug dealer.

I used to sell drugs on the street.

I did eighteen and a half years in prison, and I was a fake chemist and scientist, mixing stuff together.

ON SCREEN SUPER:

A drug dealer is not a chemist or a scientist

Didi: In front of you you'll see you have a pill; you have gloves and you have goggles

We want to talk about the possibility of any pill or any drug on the market right now potentially being laced with fentanyl that will cause a fatal overdose.

ON SCREEN SUPER:

Fentanyl is a powerful opioid 50x stronger than heroin

It can be made illegally & is mixed into drugs and made into fake pills

Didi: What does the pill look like? Does it look like a normal pill?

Students: Yes.

Didi: How does it feel to you? Does it feel like a normal pill would feel?

I want everyone to reach under their chair, and you should feel a card. Everybody's card will either have laced or not laced

Everyone raise their hands if they have the card that says laced.

ON SCREEN SUPER:

Laced:

Fentanyl is being mixed into other drugs like cocaine and heroin and it is used to make fake pills that look like prescriptions

Student 1: It's scary that it can be put into anything, and we can't even see it or notice it

ON SCREEN SUPER:

You can't see, smell, or taste if a drug contains fentanyl

Didi: So this is a potentially lethal dose of fentanyl

You see how small that is?

A lethal dose is in there

Who gets it? I won't know.

ON SCREEN SUPER:

Just 2 milligrams of fentanyl, the size of a few grains of salt, can be lethal.

Student 2: I didn't know about fentanyl until today.

Student 3: More kids should know

Student 4: More kids should know

Student 2: The last thing I wanna see is my friend on a t-shirt, you know what I mean?
