#### **SCREEN SUPER:**

Fentanyl is a powerful opioid 50x stronger than heroin

#### **ON SCREEN SUPER:**

It can be made illegally & is mixed into drugs and made into fake pills

James: The reason why I'm here is because I myself used to be a dealer, I used to deal drugs. What's your name?

Lewis: Lewis

James: Lewis? Okay, nice to meet you. What's your name?

Linette: My name is Linette

## James: Linette?

Guys when I was dealing, I didn't care what anyone's name was. I didn't ask anybody what their name was. You know I just, I sold, I was just trying to make money. The dealers they don't care about your names, they don't care about you, all they care about is making money.

# **ON SCREEN SUPER :**

Fentanyl is: Cheap, potent, and profitable For dealers even if it's more likely to cause a fatal overdose

James: Why don't you come over here and I'll have you, I'll have you ask the class this question.

**Student 1:** Out of all the overdose deaths in 2020 for people aged 14 - 23, what percent of them involved fentanyl?

(Students clamoring, jumbled answers)

Student 1: 76%

**On Screen Super:** 

2020 overdose deaths for people aged 14-23, 76% involved fentanyl

Student 2: Do you know if you sold anything that was laced with fentanyl?

James: Truthfully, I actually don't know. I don't. Any of the other drugs that I sold I do not know what was in them. I do not know.

## **ON SCREEN SUPER:**

Most of the time dealers don't even know what's in the drugs they're selling.

## James: We use people to test. I wasn't testing it.

It travels through too many hands for a person to know what's in anything. You know, you can OD from that.

## **ON SCREEN SUPER:**

Just 2 milligrams of fentanyl, the size of a few grains of salt, can be lethal.

Student 2: Why would a drug dealer put a lethal dose of fentanyl in drugs if they know it's so harmful?

James: It's really just all about the money.

**Student 3:** I just didn't realize that one pill could change your whole life.

**Student 1:** Fentanyl's not really something that is really talked about.

**Student 4:** I think we need to be more educated so that we can inform more people and we can stop letting teenagers die.

**Student 3:** That really took like a really big toll on me cause I was like wow, you're never gonna know if it's mixed or not.
